Additional Social Action programmes at Leo Baeck, Haifa include: Medical Clowns & entertainment for children in hospitals; a lunch voucher scheme for poor children, scholarships for primary school aged children from Ethiopian immigrant families & more.

The Leo Baeck Education Center provides 2,300 children from Reception to Year 12 with a first class education infused with the highest Jewish and universal humanitarian values; and impacts on some 35,000 people in Haifa of all faiths and identities in Israel - Jewish, Christian, Muslim, Druze and Baha'i.
